POSITION SUMMARY:

Provide in-person Level 1 and Level 2 ASL instruction to adult learners.

FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **Level 1:** Teach American Sign Language to adults who have no experience with ASL or who need a refresher on the basics: ASL manual alphabet, numbers, greetings, feelings, expressions, family, time, clothes, body parts and other basic conversational tools.
- **Level 2:** Teach signs relating to verbs and basic conversational style. Focus on the basic formation of grammatically correct sentence structure for ASL. For those who have completed ASL Level 1, or who have comparable experience.

REQUIREMENTS

- Prior experience teaching ASL classes to hearing adults
- If necessary, provide interpreter for each class

- Instruction in-person once per week (typically at night, between 6:00 and 9:00 p.m.) in Arlington, MA
- Availability to teach Fall 2022 for up to 12 weeks (with potential to continue)
